To help strengthen family involvement in reading, Page Ahead offers a workshop for parents & caregivers. A Page Ahead trainer can come to your preschool to present the Families Read workshop.

Families Read is an interactive workshop for parents and caregivers of children from birth to six. It offers tips on reading aloud, suggestions for selecting appropriate books, and ideas for incorporating reading into daily routines. The workshop also promotes talking together with children to increase vocabulary. The 90-minute workshop includes a model read aloud, lots of discussion, and hands-on activities.

Please note that we require a minimum of 10 adults and a maximum of 50. Workshops can be scheduled any day or time, depending on trainer availability.

Workshop length: 90 minutes

Cost: Free!

Audience: Parents / caregivers of young children (no children, please)

Participants receive: Literacy handouts and a new children's book

Languages: Workshop available in English or Spanish (materials in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Somali)
